Sheriff Stuart Swears In New Staff at ACSO

On July 24th, 2017 Anoka County Sheriff James Stuart administered the oath of office to 4 new staff members. Detention Deputies Jai Vang, Cory Lindsholm and Lisa Miller took their oaths along with new Deputy Sheriff William Jacobson.

Detention Deputy Jai Vang: Detention Deputy Vang has an associate of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from North Hennepin Community College and is currently finishing his Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice at St. Cloud State University. Prior to employment with the Sheriff's Office, he was employed with the City of Brooklyn Park as a youth worker for at – risk youth.

Detention Deputy Cory Lindsholm: Detention Deputy Lindsholm has an Associate of Science Degree in Law Enforcement from North Hennepin Community College and completed his Law Enforcement Skills Program at Hennepin Technical College. Prior to employment as a Detention Deputy, Lindsholm has worked for the Anoka Police Department as a Security Officer, the Anoka County Sheriff's Office in a variety of positions and had worked as a CAD designer for a private company.

Detention Deputy Lisa Miller: Detention Deputy Miller has a Bachelor's Degree in Law Enforcement and Corrections from Minnesota State University and a Master of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from West Chester University of Pennsylvania. Prior to employment with the Sheriff's Office she was employed as a Student Lead Patrol Officer with MSU security and as a Graduate Research Assistant at West Chester University of Pennsylvania.

All the newly sworn Detention Deputies begin their service in the Jail Division.

Deputy Sheriff William Jacobson: Deputy Jacobson has a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from St. Cloud State University. Deputy Jacobson has previously been employed as a Deputy Sheriff for the Sherburne County Sheriff's Office and as a Reserve Officer with the Centennial Lakes Police Department. Deputy Jacobson begins his assignment in the Patrol Division.
