Pedestrians Struck and Injured while Crossing Highway 47

On Tuesday, November 20, 2018, at 5:53 p.m., emergency personnel were called to the intersection of Highway 47 and Pederson Dr. NW in the City of St. Francis regarding two pedestrians that were struck by a vehicle and were injured at the location. Early investigation indicates that two 14-year old females were crossing the highway in a crosswalk and were struck by a northbound vehicle. The vehicle, which stopped at the scene, was driven by a 62-year-old male of Isanti, MN.

One of the injured pedestrians was transported to the Hennepin County Medical Center and is in Critical Condition. The other injured pedestrian was transported to Mercy Hospital and is in Serious Condition. The crash remains under investigation by the St. Francis Police Department, the Minnesota State Patrol, and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office. There are no additional details to be released at this time.
