On Sunday, April 21, 2019, at approximately 0110 hours, members of the St. Francis Police Department and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office responded to the area of 229 Ave. NW at Arrowhead St. in the City of St. Francis on a report of a single motor vehicle crash in which the vehicle involved, was now on fire. Law enforcement arrived on scene and the vehicle was fully engulfed in flames. The St. Francis Fire Department extinguished the fire and two people were found deceased inside of the vehicle.

Preliminary information indicates that the vehicle was traveling westbound on 229th Ave. NW, then entered the south ditch, struck a tree, and caught fire. The crash is being investigated by the St. Francis Police Department, the Minnesota State Patrol, the Midwest Medical Examiner's Office, and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office. At this time, there is no further information to be released. Further updates will follow when they become available.
