This release is meant to add to the press release issued on May 22, 2019 by the United States Attorney's Office (Minnesota) regarding defendant PHELIXUS FITZGERALD MAR ROBINSON, a/k/a "Storm".

In early 2019 the Anoka-Hennepin Narcotics and Violent Crimes Task Force began months long investigation into the distribution of Heroin in Anoka, Hennepin, and Ramsey counties. The investigation resulted in the seizure of more than nine pounds of Heroin, multiple firearms, more than \$545,000 in cash and the arrest of the defendant.

This investigation was conducted and completed by the Anoka-Hennepin Narcotics and Violent Crimes Task Force, which is comprised of 10 law enforcement agencies from Anoka and Hennepin counties. Upon the arrest of the defendant, the case was then turned over to the Drug Enforcement Administration and United States Attorney's Office for consideration of federal charges.

**SAINT PAUL FELON CHARGED WITH HEROIN DISTRIBUTION, ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF SIX FIREARMS**

United States Attorney Erica H. MacDonald today announced a federal indictment charging PHELIXUS FITZGERALD MAR ROBINSON, a/k/a "Storm," 44, with possession and distribution of heroin and firearms violations.[1] ROBINSON was arrested and made an initial appearance today before Magistrate Judge Steven E. Rau in U.S. District Court in St. Paul, Minnesota.

According to the allegations in the indictment, in March 2019, ROBINSON distributed heroin and knowingly possessed, with the intent to distribute, more than one kilogram of heroin. ROBINSON was also in possession of six firearms, including a Glock model 22 .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol, a Taurus model Protector .38 caliber revolver, a Beretta model 96 .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol, a Glock model 30 .45 caliber semi-automatic pistol, a Bersa model Thunder .380 caliber semi-automatic pistol, and a SCCY model CPX-2 9mm semi-automatic pistol. The firearms and more than \$545,000 in cash were seized by law enforcement from two separate storage lockers belonging to ROBINSON. Because he is a felon, ROBINSON is prohibited under federal law from possessing any type of firearm at any time.

This case is the result of an investigation conducted by the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Coon Rapids Police Department. This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, an initiative that brings together all levels of law enforcement and the communities they serve to reduce violent crime and make our neighborhoods safer for everyone.

Assistant United States Attorney Thomas Calhoun-Lopez is prosecuting the case.
