Oak Grove Personal Injury Motor Vehicle Crash

On February 17, 2020 at approximately 4:26 pm, Oak Grove Fire Department and the Anoka County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to the intersection of Lake George Blvd. NW and 197th Ave. NW in the City of Oak Grove on a report of a personal injury crash. Upon arrival first responders located two vehicles involved in the crash. A 30-year-old female from Coon Rapids was found in critical condition and was transported by Allina Ambulance to HCMC. The other driver involved, a 50-year-old male from St. Francis, was not injured. There were no passengers in either vehicle.

Preliminary information suggests that the female, driving in a Toyota Camry, was traveling southbound Lake George Blvd. and lost control on the slippery, snow covered roadway, slid sideways and was struck broadside by the male, driving northbound in a GMC pickup truck pulling an enclosed trailer. At this time, it is not believed that alcohol was a factor in this crash. The roadway will be closed between 197th Ave. and 199th Ave. for an extended time while this crash is investigated.

This incident remains under investigation by the Minnesota State Patrol, and Anoka County Sheriff's Office. No additional information will be provided at this time.
