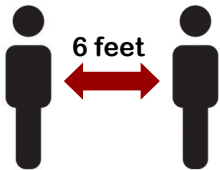
# Workhouse Safety Precautions

**Safety is our top priority.** The Anoka County Workhouse has implemented policies to reduce the risk of COVID-19 spread in the facility. We ask for your cooperation by following the safety procedures below. Please see a staff member with any questions.



### Separation Period

All new intakes will be separated from the general inmate population for approximately two weeks. We will closely monitor your health during this time. Please inform staff immediately if you feel ill or develop a fever, cough, shortness of breath, or other respiratory symptoms.



### Social Distancing

Inmate residents should remain at least **6 feet apart** at all times and in all areas of the building. This includes in hallways, sleeping rooms, day rooms, and the cafeteria. Follow all posted signs for proper spacing.



### Face Masks

Face masks significantly reduce the risk of spread. You must wear a mask during the initial intake separation period and are strongly encouraged to wear one in the general population. Masks are available from staff and will be exchanged daily.



### Personal Hygiene

Good hygiene practices are extremely important. Throughout the day and before and after meals, thoroughly wash your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.



### Building Cleaning

Inmate residents are expected to clean and disinfect the building throughout the day. You will be provided instructions on the proper use of disinfectants and areas to clean.
