Juvenile charged in teen's shooting death

The Anoka County Attorney's Office has filed criminal charges against a 16-year-old male for his role in the fatal shooting of a 15-year-old female in Columbia Heights this week.

Damico Jamal-Toyko High, of Minneapolis, was charged Tuesday with second-degree manslaughter.

High was charged by juvenile delinquency petition and the Anoka County Attorney's Office is seeking to have him certified as an adult. High's next court hearing is scheduled for April 26.

Because High is charged with a felony and was at least 16 years old at the time of the alleged crime, the juvenile delinquency petition is deemed public data.
