



2022 CRIMINAL EXPUNGEMENT CLINIC – FREE

Expungement is the process of going to court to ask a judge to seal a court record. People request an expungement when they have been denied a job, housing, or a professional license because of a criminal incident that shows up on a background check.

Attend an informational session and if you qualify financially meet individually with an attorney regarding whether this is a realistic option for your situation. No pre-registration is necessary. Sessions will take place at the Anoka County Government Center in the room number listed after the date below. **Sessions start at 1:30 p.m.**

Court forms will be provided to all registrants, or they can be picked up at the Law Library for free.
