

Access to Disability and Senior Services

Request a MnCHOICES assessment:

Complete a MnCHOICES assessment

A certified assessor will conduct an assessment in your home or another preferred location. This assessment can take up to three hours to complete.

Eligibility Determination

A certified assessor will review supports and services you may be eligible for based on assessment outcomes and eligibility for publicly funded assistance.

Are you open to MA and/or certified disabled (if required for program)?

YES

A certified assessor will work with a financial eligibility specialist and waiver review team to open individuals to Programs.

NO

A certified assessor and financial eligibility specialist will assist with financial applications and/or SMRT referral to secure funding and disability certification to open individuals to programs.

NOT ELIGIBLE

for publicly funded assistance. A certified assessor will discuss other services and resources available.

Ongoing Services

A waiver review committee will make the final determination on program or waiver assignment. A case manager will be assigned for all persons opening to a program and will discuss options for services for individuals [under 65](#) or [over 65](#).

Annual Reassessment

For all individuals open to waiver or state-plan services, a case manager will refer you for an annual reassessment to determine ongoing eligibility for programs.

**Assessment and eligibility timelines can vary dependent upon individual circumstances.
