Anoka county pays an At-risk program rate to identified programs that serve Teen Parents attending High School or GED. The fund plan county optional policy is to pay the approved Hennepin County at-risk rates.

Hennepin at-risk programs rates have changed.

- The Weekly rate for Hennepin County at-risk facilities will change from 5X the Daily rate to 20% above the last approved At-Risk Facility Rate approved on 11/15/2021.
- The Hourly and Daily rates will be the CCAP county maximum rate as identified in the [20% Quality Differential Maximum Rates effective 10/30/2023](#).
