Route 10 Southbound - 25 min



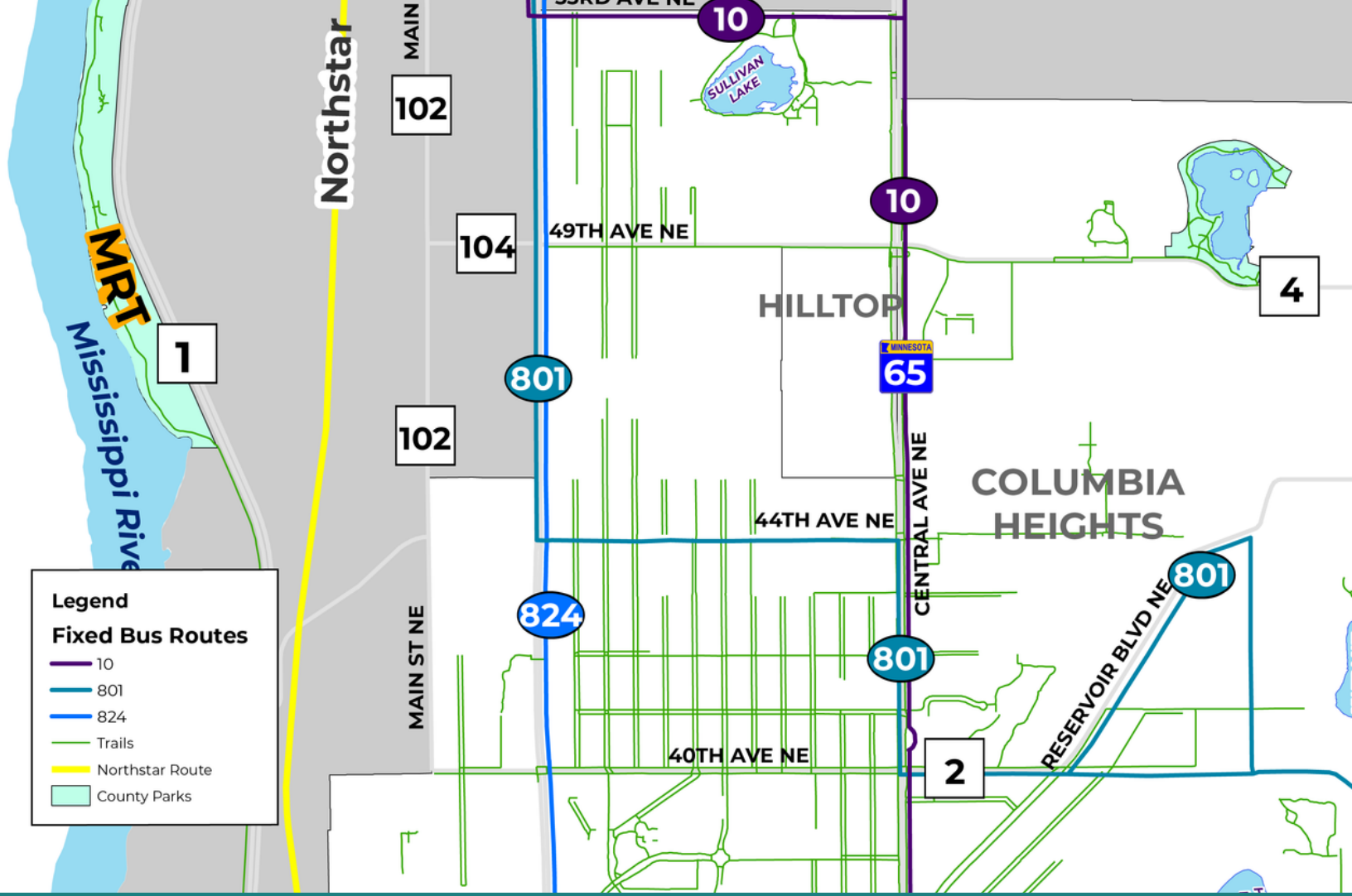
Columbia Heights Transit Center to Rosedale Mall
