



## Coon Rapids

- Multi-use paths, sidewalks, and bike trails are found throughout the city.
- Multiple bus routes across the city to take you around Anoka County and to Minneapolis.
- Most **major destinations are accessible by transit and by biking.**
- Multiple car-free or car-lite. **commutes to downtown** Minneapolis with **travel times around 25 minutes.**
- Metro Transit **F-Line** will bring **rapid bus service** to the Central Avenue and University Avenue corridors south of the city, replacing the busy Route 10.

## Options are abundant for Coon Rapids commuters

**Coon Rapids** offers suburban living with great access to the region's urban amenities. Bike, carpool, or take the bus/train to downtown for work or play—**you'll be surprised how quickly and easily Coon Rapids residents can get downtown without worrying about parking or traffic.**

Transit service is widespread across the city. Major destinations like Coon Rapids High School, Anoka-Ramsey Community College, and Riverdale Mall are just steps away from transit.

The city is also home to the busiest station on the Northstar line. Ride your scooter, bike, or e-bike to the station and take it with you on the train to make your last-mile more convenient—all without a car.



**Transit by bus or train to downtown Minneapolis in 20 minutes, biking in 45 minutes.**



**Transit Link** is the region's dial-a-ride service that is used for areas without fixed-route buses and will typically connect customers to fixed route services to their destination. **Call 763-324-3250 to get started.**

**Metro Mobility** is a paratransit service specifically for certified riders with disabilities or health issues. The service area doesn't include all of the county, but does serve Coon Rapids. **Call 651-602-1111 to get started.**



## Trains & Buses

Local Bus: 805  
Express Bus: 850, 852  
Northstar Commuter Rail

- **Northstar Commuter Rail** - Big Lake to Target Field via Coon Rapids.
- **Route 805** - Anoka to Northtown Mall.
- **Route 850** - Express bus between Coon Rapids and Minneapolis.
- **Route 852** - Express bus between Anoka and Minneapolis that makes local stops in Coon Rapids and at park and rides.
- **Other Routes** - Other active or suspended routes that stop at Northtown Mall but do not generally serve Coon Rapids.

- Foley Blvd P&R to US Bank Stadium/Downtown East**  
Route 850 Green Line to US Bank Stadium - 30 min
- Coon Rapids Dam to Nicollet Mall**  
Mississippi River Trail or West River Road - 1 hr 10 min
