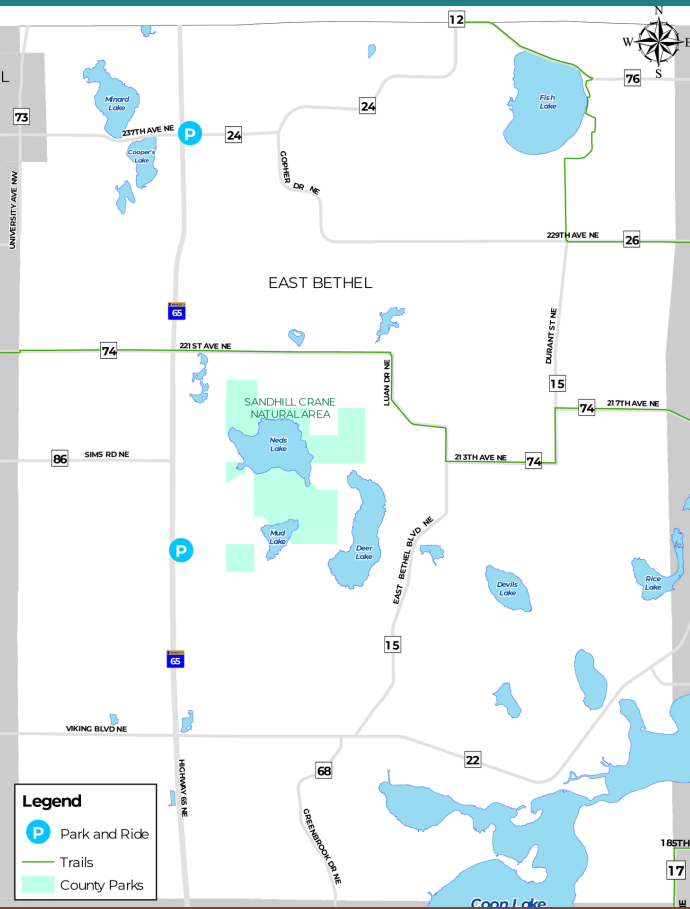




## East Bethel



### Park & Ride

While East Bethel has no fixed-route transit service, a drive down MN-65 to the **95th Ave Park and Ride** in Blaine helps you cut your driving and your gas costs in half with free parking and a ~30-minute ride to the heart of downtown Minneapolis on **Route 250** and a 20-minute ride to the U of M on **Route 252**.



### Transit Link

Transit Link is the region's dial-a-ride service that is used for areas, like East Bethel, without fixed-route buses and will typically connect customers to fixed route services to get to their destination. Transit Link serves all of Anoka County, but rides must be scheduled ahead. **Call 763-324-3250 to get started.**



### Carpooling/Vanpooling

## Upcoming Construction

Major construction is coming to the Highway 65 corridor in Blaine as MnDOT, Anoka County, and the City of Blaine make infrastructure upgrades to improve MN-65's safety for all road users, including drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The project, dubbed **Thrive on 65**, is still in the final planning phases but construction is slated to begin in 2025/2026.
