



## Fridley

- Multiple sustainable commutes to downtown Minneapolis with travel times around 20 minutes.
- Mississippi River Trail (MRT) offers bike commuting to both Minneapolis and St. Paul.
- Transit routes 10, 824, 852, and Northstar stop in Fridley.
- Park and ride facility at Fridley Northstar station connecting to Route 852 express bus service on East River Rd.
- Metro Transit F-Line will bring rapid bus service to Central & University Avenues.

Fridley is among the Twin Cities inner-ring suburbs that are quickly becoming the most desirable communities in the Twin Cities. With multiple transit routes and great access to regional and local bike trails, Fridley residents have a variety of options for getting around car-free or car-light. Whether you're commuting to work, walking to the grocery store, or taking the kids to school, you can keep the car at home and try a new way of getting around.

This Get-Around Guide will share key information including major transit stations, regional bike trails, and travel time to destinations in Anoka County and around the Twin Cities area.

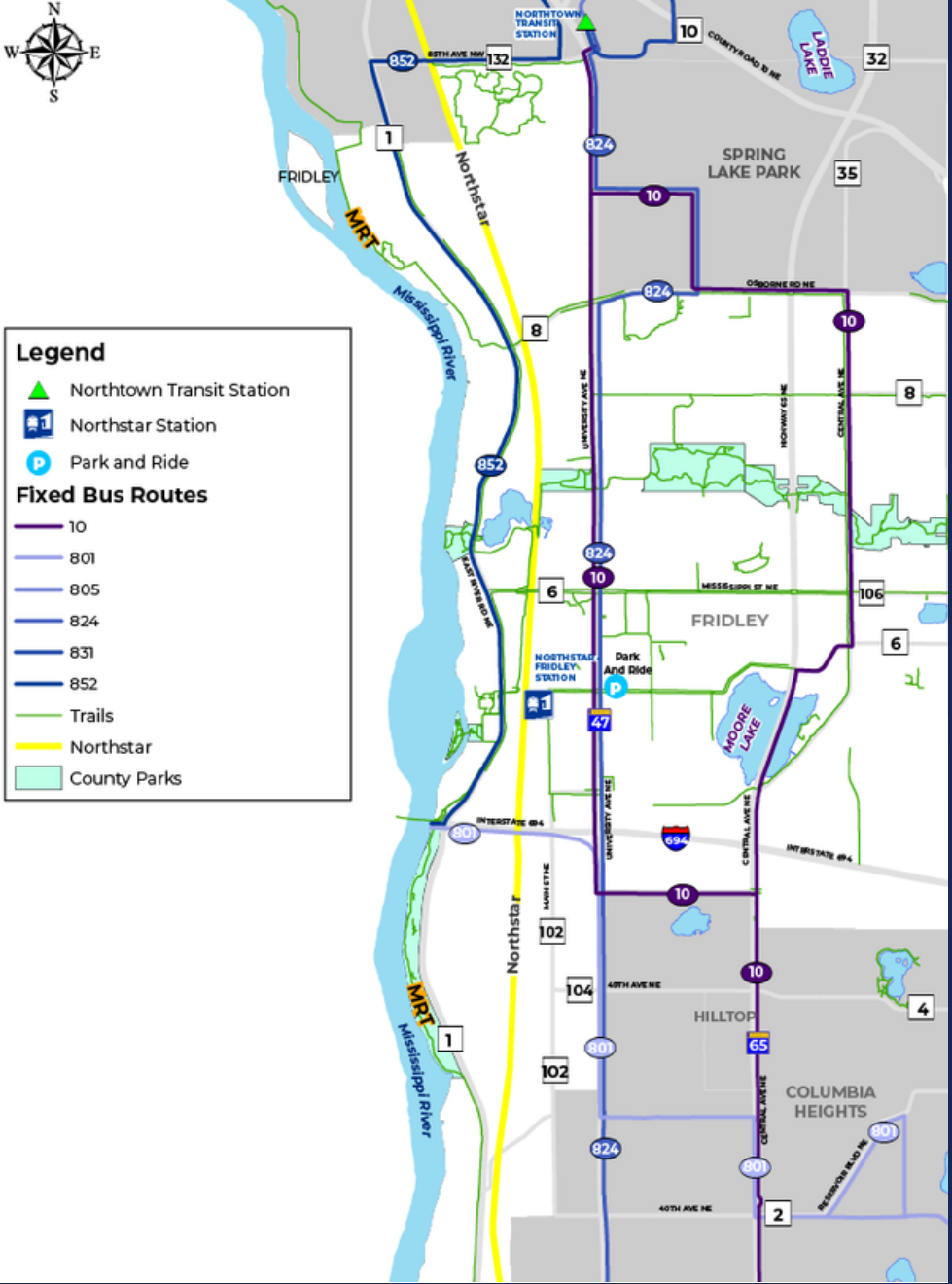


**Transit by bus or train to downtown Minneapolis in 20 minutes, biking in 45 minutes**



**Transit Link** is the region's dial-a-ride service that is used for areas without fixed-route buses and will typically connect customers to fixed route services to their destination. **Call 763-324-3250 to get started.**

**Metro Mobility** is a paratransit service specifically for certified riders with disabilities or health issues. The service area doesn't include all of the county, but does serve Fridley. **Call 651-602-1111 to get started.**



## Trains & Buses

Local Bus: 10  
 Express Bus: 852, 824  
 Northstar Commuter Rail

- **Northstar Commuter Rail** - Big Lake to Target Field via Fridley
- **Route 10** - Local bus service along Central and University Ave traveling between Northtown and downtown Minneapolis.
- **Route 801** - Local bus that runs between Roseville and Brooklyn Center via Fridley/Columbia Heights.
- **Route 824** - Runs along Route 10 and makes no stops between Fridley and downtown Minneapolis.
- **Route 852** - Express bus between Anoka and Minneapolis that makes local stops in Fridley and stops near Fridley station.



## Carpool & Vanpool

## Biking & Walking

Mississippi River Trail (MRT)  
 Sidewalks along most streets separate from road traffic

Fridley has a great collection of trails and bike lanes that connect to multiple routes in the state and region. Metro Transit has bike lockers at Fridley station and allows bikes and e-bikes on trains so you can bike and ride to your next trip to downtown Minneapolis. The MRT is a mostly flat commuter route along the river that goes through both downtowns.
