



Spring Lake Park

- Bike lanes and connections to regional bike trails
- Transit routes **10 & 824** make stops in Spring Lake Park
- Northtown Transit Center is a short bus ride, or a short drive to use the Park and Ride
- Fast commute to the Twin Cities for carpools/vanpools
- **Metro Transit F-Line** will bring **rapid bus service to Central & University Avenues between Northtown and Downtown**

81st Ave NE & Monroe St NE to Downtown
Route 824 Southbound - 39 min



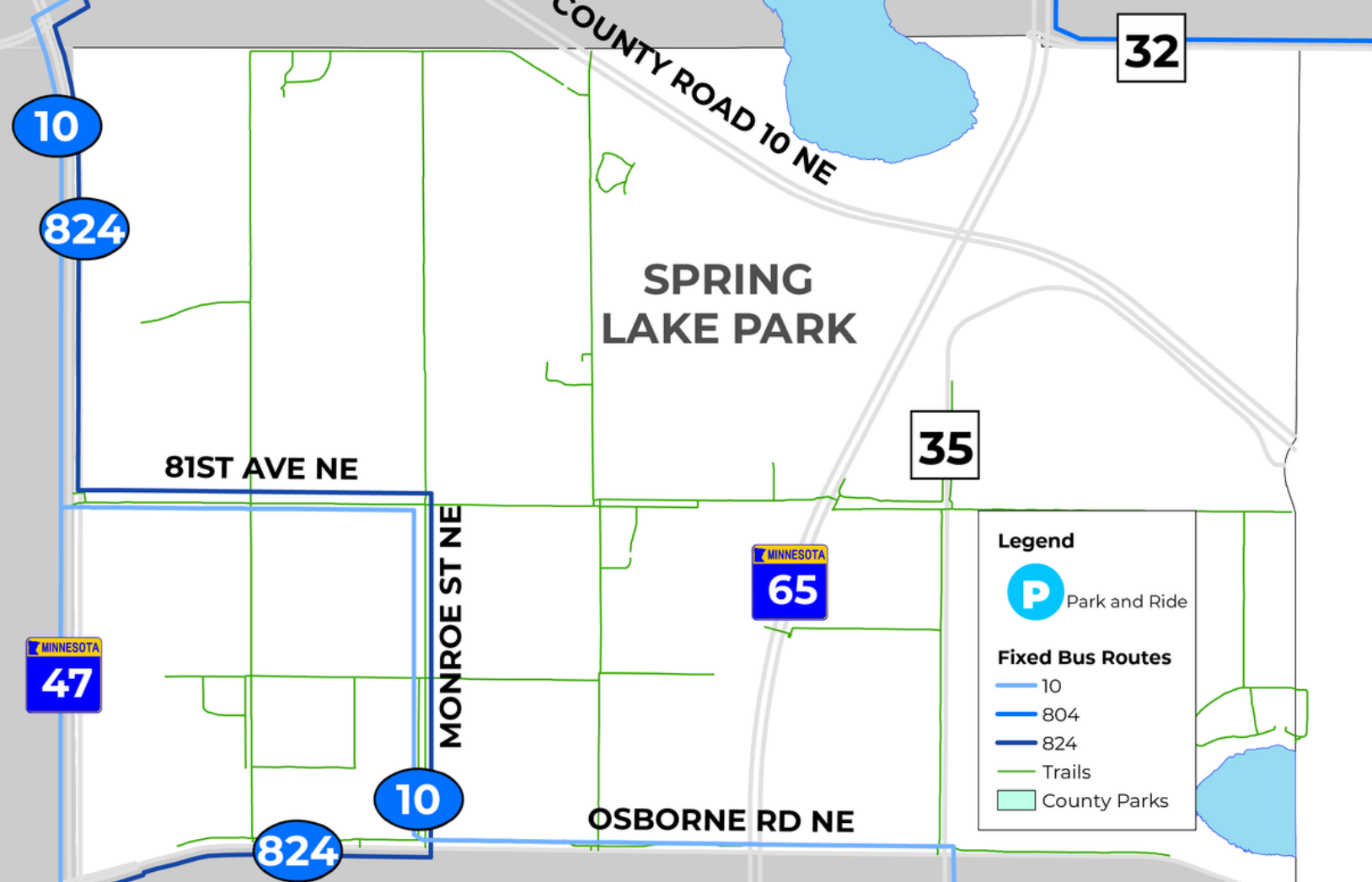
Residential Areas to Spring Lake Park HS
5-15 minutes by bike in most of Spring Lake Park



Northtown P&R to Downtown (Carpool)
Via MN-47 or MN-65 - 20 min



The new **METRO F Line** bus rapid transit corridor will bring improved bus service to the route 10 corridor, including through Spring Lake Park

Walking Options

Sidewalks run along nearly every street in Columbia Heights and help make Central Ave vibrant and lively

Spring Lake Park is bisected by MN-65. The communities on either side are aligned with the street grid and schools, churches, and commercial areas are within walking distance for many people.
