## 10/5 Program

Youth ordered to complete the 10/5 program at the East Central Regional Juvenile Center will be committed to the program for 10 days but may complete in 5 days based on positive behavior and successful completion. Youth are programmed individually, complete treatment assignments, community work service, and attend school daily.

Sunday: 1:00-5:00 p.m.  
(2 hour limit)

Wednesday: 6:30-8:30 p.m.  
(1 hour limit)

Saturday: 7:00-9:00 a.m.  
(1 hour limit)

- \* Legal guardians are able to visit along with sibling over the age of 18 with valid photo ID, all other visitors must be approved prior to visit.
- \* Leave all belonging secured in your vehicle (cellphones, purses, etc).
- \* Vending machines on-site, no food or drink items will be allowed into the building.

## About Us

Serving both males and females 10 to 18 years of age, the East Central Regional Juvenile Center (RJC) offers short term programming with three separate groups. The all male detention group consists of youth awaiting court hearings and/or waiting to go to their next placement. The all female program group consists of youth awaiting court hearings, placement, or who have been adjudicated and are completing court ordered programs. The third all male program group consists of adjudicated youth completing court ordered programs.

### Parent/Guardian Checklist:

- ✓ **Medical insurance card/information**
- ✓ **Clothing & hygiene (provided by the facility, no personal clothing will be allowed)**
- ✓ **Prescription medication (must be in original bottle/packaging with prescription label)**
- ✓ **Limited money will be accepted for youth, facility provides canteen money for youth weekly**
