## CABINETS & DRAWERS

**Magnetic Locks**, such as the following, and **Keyed locks** are effective for cabinets and drawers.



**Standard Tot Locks** such as those below are not as reliable to make hazardous items “inaccessible”.



# LOCKS Cont'd

## DOORS

Door locks and latches must meet the following guidelines:

- Children can open a closet door from the inside of the closet.
- Bathroom door can be unlocked from the outside.
- The opening device is readily accessible to all caregivers.
- Double cylinder (key required both side) locks in exit doors are prohibited.

Doorknob covers are acceptable.



Fingerguards for flush fit or bi-fold doors are acceptable.
